September 29

Day 1: Arrive Basel

Arrive in Basel, Switzerland today. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a John Hall's Alaska representative and transferred to your luxury hotel for one night. The remainder of the day is open for exploring your surroundings.

Day 2: Basel Touring

This morning will include breakfast before you are transferred to the pier to board your boutique cruising vessel, the SS. Antoinette.

Day 3: Breisach, Germany

Breisach is your gateway to the Alsatian wine road, your launching point for one of two excursions. You can visit Kaysersberg and Riquewihr, two of the most picturesque villages in the region, sampling local delicacies and getting a feel for daily life, or take a tour of the larger town, Colmar, considered one of the most beautiful destinations along the wine road. Enjoy the festive Captain's Welcome Reception and Gala Dinner.

Day 4: Kehl, Germany

The Alsatian town of Strasbourg boasts a UNESCO-designated city center, a grand Gothic cathedral and half-timbered houses. Day 5: Mannheim, Germany

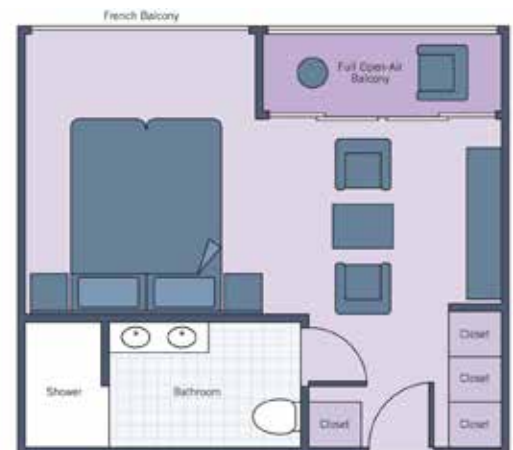

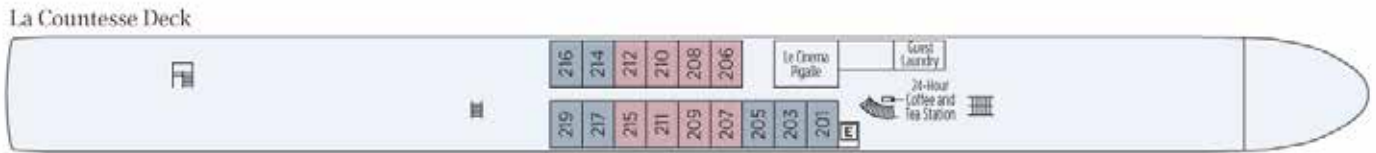
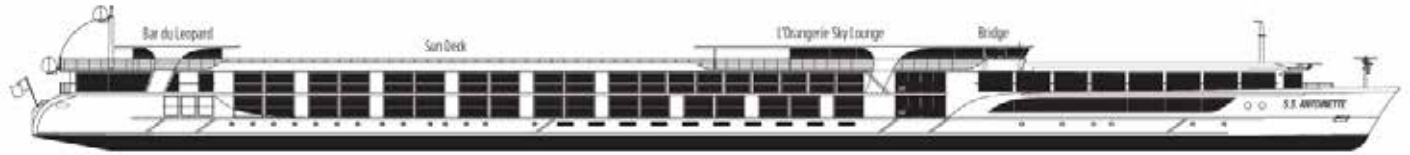

General Information

RESERVATIONS

Reservations may be made directly to John Hall's Alaska by mail, telephone, or in person. This tour is open to John Hall's Alaska alumni and friends or family that will be touring alongside the alumni.

DEPOSITS

To confirm your reservation please send a deposit of \$750.00 per person within ten days of your reservation. To reserve your space by credit card, please contact our office.

FINAL PAYMENTS

Final Payment must reach John Hall's Alaska 120 days prior to tour departure date. If payment is not received on time, space may be released; re-booking will be subject to availability. Mastercard, Visa, Discover, American Express, and personal checks are acceptable forms of payment. A discount of \$200 per person will be extended for tours paid by cash or check. (\$750 per person deposits may still be made by credit card). There are no friends and family discounts available with this tour.

CANCELLATIONS

If a cancellation is made in writing inside of 365 days prior to departure, a full refund will be made. For cancellations made less than 365 days prior to departure, the following per person charges apply: \$200 per person. In the event of interruption or cancellation of your tour after its commencement, there will be no refunds.

FLIGHTS

This tour begins in Basel, Switzerland and ends in Amsterdam, Netherlands. Upon completion of the tour, you may return home on flights from Amsterdam after 10am. We recommend flights after 12pm so that you don't miss breakfast. Due to TSA security checks and customs, please arrive at your local airport 3 hours prior to the plane departure time.

MOBILITY RESTRICTIONS

This tour will require the ability to walk an easy mile or two on cobbled and sometimes uneven pavement. Some attractions and historic sites (i.e. castles) may only be accessed fully by taking uneven and small stairs. Please be aware of these requirements before joining the tour.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Special dietary requests, specific medical conditions, physical disabilities or other special needs requirements must be noted at the time of booking. We do not discriminate against persons on the basis of disability and seek, to the furthest extent possible, to accommodate any person with a disability. Although we are unable to guarantee that all special meal or diet requests may be available, we will request where appropriate. In particular, please let us know if you have had a recent change in a medical condition such as change of diet. This tour is not recommended for those requiring the use of a mobility device that may include a wheelchair, scooter or walker.

TIPPING/GRATUITIES

All gratuities have been included in the price of your package with the exception of your John Hall's Alaska Tour Representative. This includes all waitering staff, guides, cruise staff and luggage handling gratuities while on tour. Tipping your John Hall's Alaska Tour Representative is not required and should reward exemplary service.

PACKING RECOMMENDATIONS

We recommend wearing comfortable, smart-casual clothing both onshore and onboard. We also suggest sturdy walking shoes, as you will do a significant amount of walking on shore excursions, often over cobblestones or uneven terrain. A sun hat, rain gear, and a coat or wrap for chilly evenings are useful items to have. For dining ashore, concerts, special events onboard, etc., men may want to bring a sports jacket and women a cocktail dress or pantsuit. Neckties are optional. Please note that shorts are not allowed at dinner aboard the ship. Please remember that Europe is more formal than the United States when it comes to expected dinner attire. Golf club appropriate attire is required in the evenings and during dinner (i.e. no jeans).

TOUR DOCUMENTS

Tour documents, including detailed itinerary, luggage tags, and passenger lists will be mailed approximately 14-21 days prior to departure. This may be delayed if final payment is not received on time.

ITINERARY REVISIONS

John Hall's Alaska reserves the right to revise the services included in the itinerary such as hotel accommodations and attractions. In cases of substitution, a comparable quality service will be used.

VISA & PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

At this time, US and Canadian citizens do not require a visa to visit Europe on this itinerary. You will be required to carry a passport good for 6 months past the date of return. We ask that guests furnish John Hall's Alaska with passport numbers and expiration dates at the time of booking or soon thereafter. We will alert you if changes are made to this current policy.

PAYING FOR THINGS WHILE ON TOUR

Most major credit cards are widely accepted throughout Europe. Credit cards and most debit cards can be used for ATM cash withdrawals onshore (there are no ATM machines aboard the ship). We recommend bringing at least one credit card plus an ATM card. Try to avoid carrying euro notes larger than €100, as merchants may be hesitant to accept them due to counterfeiting. Limited currency exchange is available onboard the ship (cash only) and all major hotels have exchange facilities. Travelers Checks are not recommended. Let your credit card issuer and bank know of your plans to travel aboard so they can expect foreign transactions on your account.
