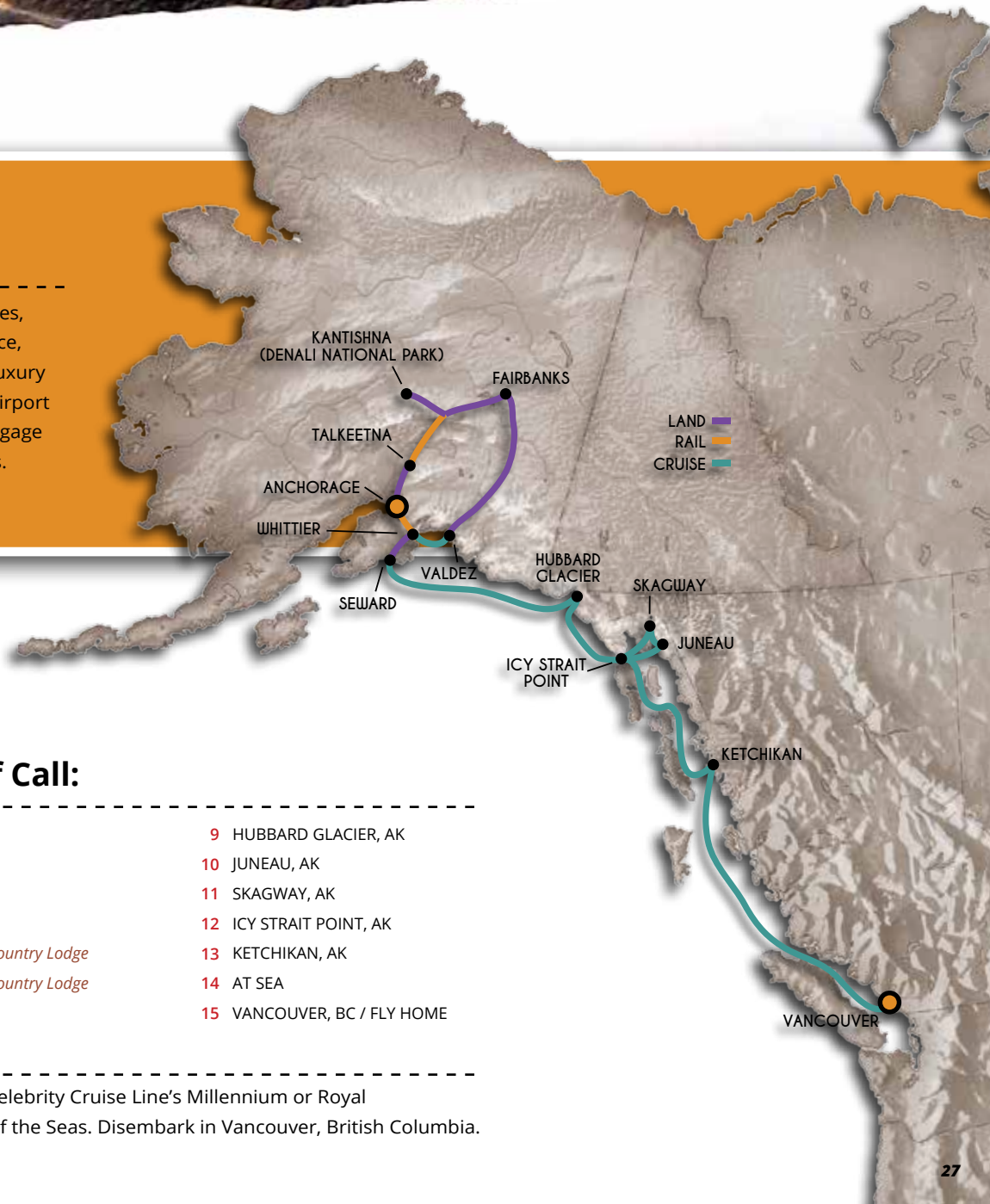

## 1 Anchorage

Arrive in Anchorage, Alaska today! We will greet you upon arrival and escort you to your luxury accommodations for this evening. *Dinner*

## 2 Prince William Sound & Valdez

After a narrated city tour of Anchorage, ride the rail to Whittier, Alaska. Enjoy a 6-8 hour, privately chartered small boat cruise through Prince William Sound viewing glaciers and wildlife. Have your camera ready to capture Humpback and Orca whales, sea lions, otters, harbor seals, puffins and eagles. Valdez is your home for the evening. *All Meals*

## 3 Keystone Canyon & Fairbanks

Explore breathtaking Keystone Canyon with the rushing waters of Bridal Veil and Horsetail Falls then ascend to the top of Thompson Pass. Stop at Wrangell-St. Elias National Park before arriving in Fairbanks. Fairbanks will be your home for the next two nights. *All Meals*

## 4 Fairbanks

Your busy day begins with a 3-hour river journey aboard the Riverboat Discovery. Later you visit Trail Breaker Kennels where you will enjoy an educational show and luncheon. Get hands-on with the puppies! Tonight you'll taste the renowned fare of the Alaska Salmon Bake before enjoying the Palace Theatre Saloon show! *All Meals*

## 5 Denali National Park, Wonder Lake & Kantishna

Board your motorcoach for a trip to the entrance of Denali National Park. Here you join a private sightseeing bus for a 92.5 mile wildlife tour. Keep a lookout for moose, caribou, Dall sheep, wolves and grizzly bears. Pass views of Mt. Denali and Wonder Lake. Overnight at the Denali Backcountry Lodge for two nights. *All Meals*

## 6 Kantishna

Go face to face with Mother Nature today. Enjoy a day of relaxation or spend your day hiking, mountain biking, or gold panning. Optional flightseeing tours of Mt. Denali are available. *All Meals*

## 7 Denali National Park & Talkeetna

Board your bus for a 5-hour wildlife tour back to the park entrance with another chance to see the "Big Five". This afternoon board the first class cars of the Alaska Railroad for a 4-hour journey to Talkeetna with lunch enjoyed en route. This evening's lodging will give you a chance to visit the quaint town of Talkeetna. *All Meals*

## 8 Kenai Peninsula & Seward

Sail at 8pm  
Return to Anchorage where you'll tour the beautiful Anchorage Museum. After lunch, continue south on the Seward Highway to your luxury cruise ship where you will sail through southeast Alaska for the next seven days. At this time you will meet your John Hall's Alaska Cruise Manager. *Breakfast & Lunch On Land - Dinner On Board*

## 9 Hubbard Glacier 2pm-6pm (Cruising)

Today's voyage takes you to the impressive ice wall of Hubbard Glacier. Hubbard is the second most active tidewater glacier in Alaska! Watch glacial ice cascade down into the ice choked waters below. *Meals On Board*

## 10 Juneau 9am-9pm

Dock in Alaska's capital city, Juneau. Take advantage of your included Juneau walking tour highlighting the history of the Juneau Douglas Mines, local and state museums, and a visit to the state capital. Optional shore excursions are available at this port. *Meals On Board*

## 11 Skagway 7am-8:30pm

Welcome to the "Gateway City to the Klondike Gold Rush"! This historic community still has the feel of an 1898 boom town. Enjoy touring this unforgettable and historic town. Optional shore excursions are available at this port. *Meals On Board*

## 12 Icy Strait Point 6:30am-3pm

Just 22 miles southeast of Glacier Bay National Park, Icy Strait Point is the only wilderness port in Alaska and has been the home land of the Hoonah Tlingit Natives for thousands of years. Optional shore excursions are available at this port. *Meals On Board*

## 13 Ketchikan 9am-6pm

Known as the "Salmon Capital of the World", this vibrant seaside community offers a number of adventures for its visitors. Today's included walking tour features stops at the Totems of Whale Park, historic Creek Street, and the Salmon Ladder. Optional shore excursions are available in this port. *Meals On Board*

## 14 Inside Passage At Sea

Hug the coastlines of Alaska and British Columbia taking in the scenery offered by the Inside Passage. Keep an eye open for humpbacks, orcas, and dolphins during your day at sea. *Meals On Board*

## 15 Vancouver, British Columbia Dock at 7am

Sail under the Lions Gate Bridge and dock at Canada Place Pier this morning. Disembark and pass through Canadian customs before being transferred to the Vancouver or Seattle (optional) airport to board your flight bound for home. *Breakfast On Board*

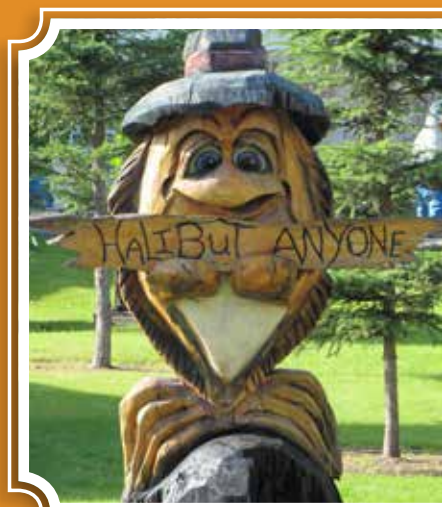
